GENERAL INFORMATION

The National Show Chairperson must be approved by the Akita Club of America board

The show chair and the treasurer **MUST** approve all expenditures that will commit the club to pay for anything over and above the regular budget of the show committee. A written contract including provisions and amounts **MUST** be provided and **MUST** be signed by the treasurer to be valid. This would include orders for W&M material, agility equipment, arrangements with judges, parties, etc

All publicity goes through the Publicity Committee and must be ready by their deadline

The Board must approve all seminars prior to May 31. All seminar organizers must provide the Board with an outline of the subject covered, equipment needed, fees, etc., and times which **MUST** be coordinated with the Show Chair.

The Show Chair, Show Committee & Site Coordinator, will arrange the Schedule of Events.

All Email notices must go through Email coordinator

NO arrangements with the hotel or grounds can be made by anyone except the Site Coordinator. At the show itself, all expenditures must be authorized by the Site Coordinator and/or the Show Chair

Workers shouldn't be penalized for volunteering to do a job for the club. Whenever possible, they should be set up close enough to the ring for them to see the show while still attending to their activities.

NATIONAL ROTATION MOTION

E-08-02-P-01 (MB): I move that the ACA implement a National Specialty site rotation plan made up of six geographical districts.

The six districts will be as follows:

NORTHWEST DISTRICT: Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, Utah

NORTH CENTRAL DISTRICT: North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, Minnesota, Michigan, Iowa, Wisconsin, Illinois, Indiana

NORTHEAST DISTRICT: Maine, Vermont, New Hampshire, Delaware, New York, Connecticut, Rhode Island, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Massachusetts, Virginia, West Virginia, New Jersey, Maryland

SOUTHWEST DISTRICT: California, Nevada, Arizona, New Mexico

SOUTH CENTRAL DISTRICT: Colorado, Kansas, Oklahoma, Texas, Missouri, Arkansas, Louisiana

SOUTHEAST DISTRICT: Kentucky, Tennessee, Alabama, Georgia, Florida, North Carolina, South Carolina, Mississippi

Beginning with the National Specialty for 2002 the rotation order will be:

2006 - North Central

2010 - Northeast

2007 - Southeast

2011 - Southwest

2008 - Northwest

2012 - North Central

2009 - South Central

2013 - Southeast
